

Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA)

- 1. Copyright in all exam materials is held or licensed by the APC.
- 2. You agree that you must not reproduce the exam materials (in whole or in part) without the prior written consent of the APC (which will be given or withheld in its absolute discretion).
